- Have a sincere faith in God and a love of Christ
- Enjoy working with others to build and provide inspiring worship experiences
- A degree in music is desirable
- Appreciate and enhance the beauty of the holy moment in keeping with the purpose of the liturgy
- Demonstrate significant musical proficiency and experience with organ and voice
- Have a high standard for yourself and be able to find and grow that in others.

General Duties:

- Play the organ and/or piano during the traditional worship services with excellence
- Play the organ at the regularly scheduled traditional liturgies of the Church, including Sunday mornings, major Christian holy days, and special services
- Assist the Choir Director

Worship Schedule:

- 8:00 AM and 11 AM from Labor Day through Memorial Day

- 8:00 AM every week in June, July, August
- 10:00 AM every other week June, July August

Compensation:

- Salary Range: \$20,000 – \$25,000 dependent on education, experience and expertise
- The Organist will have a right of first refusal to provide music services for all weddings and funerals requiring traditional music
